- Make sure that everyone in the team feels valued.
- Understand the challenges that face collaborative teams.
- Get teams to reach consensus and compromise.
- Prioritise on the wellbeing of the project.
- Keep a collaborative team focused and motivated.
- Synergise different personality types.
